Language Focus: Grammar: Subject - Verb Agreement
Rule 1: Compound subjects connected by either - or, neither - nor and or take a singular verb if the nearer subject is singular. If the nearer subject is plural, it takes plural verbs.
Rule 2: Intervening words (or words that come between subject and verb) do not affect the agreement.
